## **Recidivism by Risk Level**

As predicted by the validated risk assessment tool, Youth Level of Risk/Case Management Inventory (YLS/CMI), the total population of low risk youth who discharged successfully between June 30, 2022 and June 30, 2023 recidivated at a lower rate than the total population of moderate or high risk youth.



Statewide Recidivism Rate

82% of youth were successfully



53%

of youth that were successfully discharged from Probation, were found responsible for a subsequent qualifying adjudication within one year of their release. This current recidivism rate is reported as of June 30, 2024.
